CHAPTER 276—S. F. No. 1194

An act to permit the regulation by the school board of labor on public schools in any independent school district which is within the limits of any city of the second class.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Schools to make labor regulations.—That the school board of any independent school district which is within the limits of any city of the second class may adopt any ordinance duly enacted by the council of such second class city, including the penalty provisions for the enforcement thereof, relating to residence requirements, wage scales, and other regulations pertaining to labor on public works, and to require that it be a part of the specifications in contracts and be effective in all construction or repair work or any other public work involving the improvement of school property of such independent district.

Sec. 2. School board to adopt forms and methods.—That such school board may adopt and use the same forms and methods of regulating said ordinance as is used by the council of such city of the second class.

Sec. 3. To be additional powers.—That these powers shall be in addition to all other powers now vested in the school boards of an independent school district which is within the limits of any city of the second class.

Sec. 4. This bill shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
