with such spawning, the proceeds of the sale of such fish to be paid into the state treasury as required of other receipts of the department, provided, however, that no fish or fish eggs shall be placed in any waters unless such waters are accessible to the public for fishing purposes.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 377-S. F. No. 1031

An act to repeal Section 2719, and Section 2720, of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, relating to the marking of rubber tires or casings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law repealed.—That Section 2719 and Section 2720, of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, be and the same are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 378-S. F. No. 1036

An act authorizing the possession and use of pet reccoons for the purpose of training dogs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Pet raccoons may be kept.—It shall be lawful for any person, with the written permission of the Commissioner of Game and Fish, to keep and have in possession a raccoon and to use the same for the purpose of training dogs for the hunting of raccoons.
