
SESSION LAWS

of the

STATE OF MINNESOTA

PASSED AND APPROVED DURING THE FIFTY-FIRST SESSION OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE COMMENCING JANUARY 3, 1939



An act to appropriate money for the payment of the salary of the Lieutenant Governor and the salary and mileage of the members of the Legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and the employees of and all the other expenses of the Legislature, including payment for necessary supplies therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for legislative expense.—That the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) or so much thereof as may be found necessary, be and the same hereby is appropriated from the revenue fund for the payment of the salary of the lieutenant governor and the salary and the mileage of the members of the Legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and the employees of and all the other expenses of the Legislature, including payment for necessary supplies therefor.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
