CHAPTER 293—S. F. No. 1171

An act fixing the salary of county auditors in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salary of County Auditors in certain counties.—In all counties of this state having a land area of more than 380 and less than 400 square miles, and having a population of more than 20,000, according to the last Federal census, the salary of the county auditor shall be \$3800.00 per annum, payable in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. Effective January 1, 1939.—This act shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 1939.

CHAPTER 294—S. F. No. 1172

An act to permit the incorporation of county agricultural societies; and to provide for appropriations thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Incorporation of County Agricultural Society—Appropriations.—In any county wherein an existing county agricultural society or association shall have discontinued holding annual county fairs, and wherein a county fair has been annually held for more than ten years immediately preceding the passage of this act, whether by said agricultural society or association or by some other organization, a second county agricultural society or association may be incorporated prior to the dissolution of the existing society or association, and when so incorporated it shall be entitled to receive all benefits and appropriations that other county agricultural societies and associations receive from the state, county or municipalities under existing laws; provided, however, that not more than two annual appropriations shall be made by the
