

## RESOLUTION No. 11 (S. F. No. 442)

*A joint resolution by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota in regular session assembled assenting to the provisions of the Pittman-Robertson Act.*

WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States has enacted an act commonly known as the Pittman-Robertson Act, which is entitled an act "to provide that the United States shall aid the States in wildlife restoration projects, and for other purposes" having approval September 2, 1937; and

WHEREAS, Under the Statutes of the State of Minnesota all moneys accruing to the State of Minnesota from license fees paid by hunters and all moneys paid into the state treasury through the game and fish department, including the income from the sale of confiscated game and parts thereof and from all other sources, are appropriated for the maintenance and conduct of the activities of the commissioner of game and fish; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the act is to furnish funds to aid in wildlife restoration projects and for the further development of the game resources of the state of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, The state of Minnesota, in order to avail itself of its proportions of the funds made available under said Act, desires to assent to the provisions of the Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the legislature of the State of Minnesota in regular session assembled that the State of Minnesota assent to the provisions of the said Pittman-Robertson Act and such assent is hereby given, and that the Secretary of State is hereby directed to send certified copies of this resolution to the President of the Senate of the United States, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United States, and two copies to the Secretary of Agriculture, Henry A. Wallace, and one copy to the office of the Regional Director of the United States Department of Agriculture at Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
