## SESSION LAWS

## CHAPTER 28-S. F. No. 132

An act relating to the hours of election in all villages and towns in counties now or hereafter having a population of more than 400,000 inhabitants and modifying and repealing inconsistent acts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Hours of election in certain villages.—In all villages and townships, however organized, located in any county now or hereafter having a population of more than 400,000 inhabitants, the polls shall be kept open at any special or local election from six o'clock in the forenoon until eight o'clock in the afternoon, unless the governing body of such village or town shall, by resolution duly adopted and posted more than 30 days prior to such election, fix a different time for opening the polls, which time shall be stated in such resolution but shall not be later than nine o'clock in the forenoon.

Sec. 2. Inconsistent acts modified or repealed.—All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby amended, modified and repealed so far as necessary to give effect to the provisions of this act.

## CHAPTER 29-S. F. No. 241

An act relating to the annual tax levy by county boards for the county road and bridge fund, amending Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 2565, Subdivision 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended—annual tax levy for road and bridge fund—exception.—Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 2565, Subdivision 5, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2565. Subdivision 5. The county board at its July meeting may include in its annual tax levy an amount not exceeding ten mills on the dollar of the taxable valuation for the county road and bridge fund; provided that in any county containing according to the 1940 census, not less than 17,000 and not more than 18,000 inhabitants, and containing not less than 12 nor
