CHAPTER 318-S. F. No. 979

An act relating to wholesale produce dealers, amending Mason's Supplement 1940, Section 6240-181/2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended.—The Mason's Supplement 1940, Section $6240-18\frac{1}{2}$, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

 $6240-18\frac{1}{2}$. Dealers at wholesale.—For the purposes of this act any person who shall buy or sell or contract to buy or sell, or who shall handle in wholesale lots for the purpose of resale, or who shall handle on account of or as an agent for another, any produce as herein defined, and any person who shall similarly engage in the business of assembling and trucking produce without an established place of business, shall be deemed a dealer at wholesale; provided that cooperative associations having not more than forty per cent (40%)of non-member patrons shall not be deemed dealers at wholesale within the meaning of this Act; provided further, that no person shall be deemed a dealer at wholesale within this act who purchases, and pays, in cash, in full at the time of purchase, Minnesota seasonal grown products of the farm, orchard, vinyard, garden and apiary for transportation to destinations outside of this state and who within 72 hours thereafter transports the same to its destination outside of this state.

Section 2. Provisions severable.—The provisions of this act shall be separable, and if any provision or the application of any provision hereof shall be held unconstitutional, or invalid, it shall not effect any other provision or application thereof.
