

CHAPTER 419—S. F. No. 1336

An act relating to the powers of the commissioner of highways in the placing of signs upon highways, amending Mason's 1940 Supplement, Section 2720-161, Subdivision (a).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended—erection of traffic control devices.—Mason's 1940 Supplement, Section 2720-161, Subdivision (a), is amended to read as follows:

“(a) The commissioner shall place and maintain such traffic-control devices, conforming to the manual and specifications, upon all state trunk highways as he shall deem necessary to indicate and to carry out the provisions of this act or to regulate, warn, or guide traffic; provided, however, said commissioner may construct and maintain signs at the entrance of each city, village or borough, which sign shall have placed thereon the name of the city, village or borough and the population thereof; and provided further that the commissioner may construct and maintain other directional signs upon the trunk highways and such signs shall be uniform.”

CHAPTER 420—H. F. No. 503

An act legalizing proceedings of the governing body or the utility commission or other similar body of any village or city in connection with the issuance and sale of bonds payable from earnings of publicly owned utilities in order to affect an interest saving.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Certain bonds and bond sales legalized.—In all cases where the governing body or other similar body of any city or village has adopted proceedings for the issuance and sale of revenue bonds payable solely from the earnings of an electric light and power plant furnishing electric service to the inhabitants thereof and adjacent thereto owned by the city or village issuing the same for the purpose of refunding outstanding revenue obligations in order to affect an interest saving, such contract or proceedings are hereby legalized,
