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Sec. 4. Director may accept funds and services.—The director of the division of state parks is hereby authorized to accept in the name of the state of Minnesota any funds or services donated for the purpose of improvement of said lands for park purposes.

Sec. 5. State funds not to be used for maintenance.—No funds of the state of Minnesota shall be expended upon the maintenance of said park for a period of five years.
