

## CHAPTER 80—H. F. No. 223

*An act relating to compensation of the court reporter in certain judicial districts.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Compensation of court reporter in certain judicial district.**—The judge of the district court in any judicial district in this state, with only one judge and composed of four counties having an aggregate population of the four counties according to the last federal census of not less than 72,000 nor more than 75,000 inhabitants, may fix and establish the annual salary of the court reporter for such district in an amount not exceeding \$3,200.

## CHAPTER 81—H. F. No. 233

*An act relating to wild animals, amending Mason's Supplement 1940, Section 5586.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Law amended.**—Mason's Supplement 1940, Section 5586, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"5586. **Open season for certain fish.**—Subdivision 1. Whitefish and tullibees may be taken by means of gill nets of the sizes herein specified from such inland waters of the state as shall have been first declared open by order of the commissioner of conservation, upon the recommendation of the director of game and fish, between October 15 and December 25 following, both inclusive unless the commissioner shall set the date of opening at a later date in certain lakes, and fresh water herring may be taken by means of gill nets of the sizes herein specified from such inland waters of the state as shall have been first declared open by order of the commissioner of conservation, upon the recommendation of the director of game and fish, between November 1 and January 10 following, both inclusive, in inland lakes of the state, for private use or consumption, but not for sale, provided a license to do so shall be first obtained from the commissioner.

Subdivision 2. Said nets shall not exceed 100 feet in length nor three feet in width and the size of mesh for taking
