

## CHAPTER 353—H. F. No. 355

*An act relating to bonding probation officers, their deputies and employees in certain counties and permitting said counties to pay for said bonds.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Certain probation officers to give bond.** In any county now or hereafter having an area of over 5000 square miles and having a population of over 150,000 inhabitants having probation officers, deputies and employees who collect or have custody of money, shall execute a bond with appropriate sureties in a penal sum to be fixed by the district court judges of said county, at the expense of the county, conditioned for the true accounting of all money received by them in connection with the duties of their positions.

## CHAPTER 354—H. F. No. 356

*An act relating to tax levy for tuberculosis sanatorium in certain counties; amending Laws 1939, Chapter 54.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws of 1939, Chapter 54, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. **Tax levy in support of tuberculosis sanatorium.** In any county in this state now or hereafter having a population in excess of 150,000 and an area in excess of 5,000 square miles, there may be levied annually for the purpose of operating, maintaining, and for permanent improvements to the county tuberculosis sanatorium, such an amount as may be recommended by the Sanatorium Commission and approved and levied by the Board of County Commissioners, the rate of which tax shall not exceed *three mills* on each dollar of assessed valuation of such county exclusive of money and credits.
