

CHAPTER 364—H. F. No. 1141

An act to authorize county boards to accept funds from private sources and to expend public funds for the perpetual care of cemeteries.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Acceptance of donations. The Board of County Commissioners of any county may accept money from private sources or from any person, firm or corporation, including fiduciaries, donated for the perpetual care of cemeteries located either wholly or partly within the county, and use such funds for the purposes provided in Sec. 2.

Sec. 2. County board may expend funds in care of cemeteries. Any such Board of County Commissioners may expend public funds under its control for the purpose of maintaining and improving, and otherwise permanently caring for cemeteries located either wholly or partly within the county, but any such expenditures shall be included in, and shall not be in excess of, any limitations on expenditures now fixed by law.

Sec. 3. Donations deposited with county treasurer. All money donated or made available for use by such Board in permanently caring for such cemeteries, shall be paid into the county treasury, and kept in a separate fund and disbursed only as authorized by the County Board.

CHAPTER 365—H. F. No. 1176

An act relating to powers and duties of school boards; amending Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 125.06, Subdivision 12.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 125.06, Subdivision 12, is hereby amended to read :

125.06. Powers and duties of school board. Subd. 12. Instruction of pupils in other districts. It may, by *majority* vote, provide for the instruction of any resident pupil in another school district when inadequate room, distance to school, unfavorable road conditions, or other facts or condi-
