

## CHAPTER 41—H. F. No. 458

*An act relating to narcotic drugs, and amending Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 618.01, Subdivision 14.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 618.01, Subdivision 14, is amended to read as follows:

618.01. Subdivision 14. **Narcotic drugs.** "Narcotic drugs" means coca leaves, opium, *isonipecaine*, and every substance neither chemically nor physically distinguishable from them.

Sec. 2. **Isonipecaine.** "*Isonipecaine*" means the substance identified chemically as 1-methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester, or any salt thereof by whatever trade name identified.

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CHAPTER 42—H. F. No. 589

*An act relating to the licensing of manufacturers of commercial fertilizer; amending Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 17.21.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 17.21, is amended to read as follows:

17.21. **Certified copy of certificate filed with commissioner.** Before any commercial fertilizer is sold, or offered for sale, the manufacturer, importer, or party who causes it to be sold, or offered for sale, within the state, shall file in the office of the commissioner a certified copy of the certificate referred to in Section 17.20, and shall pay *each year* to the commissioner a license fee of ten dollars for each brand of fertilizer offered for sale or sold within the state; *provided further, that each such license shall expire one year from date of issuance.* When the manufacturer or importer shall have paid the license fee herein required for any year, no other person shall be required to pay such license fee for that brand.
