Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of Minnesota, the Senate concurring, that the purchase by the commissioner of highways of equipment for the establishment of a statewide two-way radio system be and the same is hereby approved.

RESOLUTION No. 10-S. F. No. 901

A concurrent resolution memorializing the Congress of the United States to enact such legislation as may be necessary to provide for additional hospital beds in the State of Minnesota for disabled war veterans.

WHEREAS there are at the present time approximately 2400 beds in the state of Minnesota which are available for injured and disabled war veterans, and

WHEREAS this number is entirely inadequate and there is an acute shortage in this state of beds for this purpose, and

WHEREAS there is at the present time a waiting list of about 300 such veterans who are in need of hospitalization, and

WHEREAS the number of returning veterans who need hospital treatment is increasing daily and will greatly increase in the immediate future:

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By the Senate of the state of Minnesota, the House of Representatives concurring, that the state memorialize the Congress of the United States to enact such legislation as may be necessary to provide in the immediate future for additional beds for disabled veterans in the state of Minnesota.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of state of the state of Minnesota is instructed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and to each member of Congress from the state of Minnesota.
