CHAPTER 272—H. F. No. 1123 [Not Coded]

An act relating to county fairgrounds and the improvement thereof in counties now or hereafter containing not less than 80 full or fractional congressional townships.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for county fairgrounds in certain counties. In every county in this state now or hereafter containing not less than 80 full or fractional congressional townships, the board of county commissioners is authorized to expend annually from the county revenue fund, out of any moneys not required to defray other expenses chargeable against such fund, such amount as the commissioners may determine to be necessary for the purpose of improving the county fairgrounds and erecting buildings thereon to be used for county and agricultural fairs.

CHAPTER 273—H. F. No. 1137 [Not Coded]

An act authorizing the commissioner of conservation to sell certain swamp lands.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Sale of certain swamp lands authorized. The commissioner of conservation is hereby authorized to sell lot 5, section 16, township 146, range 34, in the same manner as provided by law for the sale of other state swamp lands, notwithstanding the fact that such lands may lie within a
