CHAPTER 282—S. F. No. 869 [Coded as Section 334.021]

An act to prohibit corporations from interposing the defense of usury.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[334.021] Corporation prohibited from interposing defense of usury. Section 1. No corporation shall hereafter interpose the defense of usury in any action. The term "corporation", as used in this act, includes any association or joint stock company having any of the powers and privileges of corporations not possessed by an individual or a partnership.

CHAPTER 283—S. F. No. 1002

An act relating to commercial fishing in the boundary waters between Wisconsin and Minnesota from Lake St. Croix to the Iowa border; amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 98.46 Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 98.46, is amended to read as follows:

- 98.46. Licenses; fees. Subdivision 1. Resident licenses. Subject to all applicable provisions of chapters 97 to 102, the following licenses shall be issued to residents only, upon payment of the fees herein specified:
 - (1) To take small game, \$1.00;
- (2) To take deer with firearms and bow and arrows, \$2.25;
 - (3) To trap fur bearing animals, except beaver, \$1.00;
 - (4) To take fish, \$1.00;
- (5) Sportsmen's license, to include all the privileges granted by licenses issued under (1), (2), (3) and (4), \$5.00, plus any additional fee the licensee, at his option, desires to pay;
 - (6) Combination husband and wife, to take fish, \$1.50;
