

CHAPTER 3—S. F. No. 165

An act relating to operation of passenger trains; amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 216.62.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 216.62, is amended so as to read as follows:

216.62. **Passenger trains; discontinued only with consent of commission.** No company operating any line of railroad in this state as a common carrier of passengers shall discontinue the operation of any of its regularly scheduled intra-state passenger trains unless written application has been filed with the commission for authority so to do and an order has been made by the commission granting such authority. No such order shall be made until a hearing has been had and the commission finds that by the discontinuance of such passenger train the public will not be deprived of reasonably adequate service.

CHAPTER 4—H. F. No. 98

An act relating to tax levy for tuberculosis sanatorium in certain counties; amending Laws 1945, Chapter 354, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Tax levy in support of tuberculosis sanatorium.** Laws 1945, Chapter 354, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows

In any county in this state now or hereafter having a population in excess of 150,000 and an area in excess of 5,000 square miles, there may be levied annually for the purpose of operating, maintaining, and for permanent improvements to the county tuberculosis sanatorium, such an amount as may be recommended by the Sanatorium Commission and approved and levied by the Board of County Commissioners, the rate of which tax shall not exceed *four* mills on each dollar of assessed valuation of such county exclusive of money and credits.
