CHAPTER 453—H. F. No. 1539 [Not Coded]

An act relating to any city of the first-class now or hereafter operating under a home rule charter providing for a commission form of government consisting af a mayor and four commissioners as the sole governing body of such city, and authorizing the fixing and payment of the annual salaries of such mayor and commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salary of mayor and commissioner in certain cities. Beginning July 1, 1947, notwithstanding anything contained in any charter of any city of the first-class now or hereafter operating under a home rule charter providing for a commission form of government, consisting of a mayor and four commissioners as the sole governing body of such city, the mayor and commissioners shall each be paid a salary of \$5,500 per year, payable in equal monthly installments.

CHAPTER 454—H. F. No. 1546 [Not Coded]

An act relating to rate of tax levy for general purposes in certain villages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Limitation on tax levy in certain villages. Any village having more than 1,550 and less than 1,575 inhabitants according to the 1940 federal census within a county having more than 50,000 and less than 60,000 inhabitants is hereby authorized and empowered to annually levy for the general fund of such village a tax not exceeding 35 mills on the dollar of all taxable property in such village, according to the last preceding assessment thereof.
