## CHAPTER 5-H. F. No. 15

An act authorizing certain fourth class cities to appropriate funds from the earnings of the municipal liquor discensary to aid in the construction of a community hospital, and amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 447.045. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 447.045, is amended to read as follows:

447.045. Liquor dispensary fund appropriated for community hospital. The council of any city of the fourth class operating under a home rule charter and operating an off-sale municipal liquor dispensary may appropriate not to exceed \$125,000 from the liquor dispensary fund to any duly incorporated non-profit hospital association for the construction of a community hospital in such city governed by a board including two or more members of the city council and open to all residents of the city on equal terms. No such appropriation shall be made in any city where the average net earnings of the off-sale municipal liquor dispensary had not exceeded \$18,000 for the last five completed fiscal years preceding the date of such appropriation.

## CHAPTER 6—H. F. No. 48 [Not Coded]

An act to legalize the establishment of certain law libraries which were established pursuant to Laws 1945, Chapter 397.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Legalizing establishment of law library. In all cases where a law library has been established by an order of a judge of a district court, who was not a resident of the county in which the library was established but was a judge of the district court of the judicial district in which the county is situated, which order was issued and the proceedings had thereon pursuant to Laws 1945, Chapter 397, all such proceedings are hereby legalized and confirmed.
