retaliation might become embarrassing and oppressive if the South Dakota Legislature gives serious consideration to discriminatory proposals of this nature.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, in regular session assembled, that we respectfully request the Legislature of our neighboring sister state of South Dakota to discard any proposals before it which would result in discriminating against the residents of this state seeking to enjoy the opportunities of hunting migratory water fowl which may be afforded to the residents of South Dakota.
