An act relating to deputies and clerical help of the sheriff and providing automobile and other expenses, in counties having more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants; amending Laws 1947, Chapter 457, Sections 1 and 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. That Laws 1947, Chapter 457, Section 1, be amended to read:
- Section 1. Deputies and employees of sheriff of Ramsey county; use of automobile. The sheriff in any county having more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants shall appoint and employ one chief deputy, one chief criminal deputy and two assistants, ten court bailiffs, one chief patrol deputy and twelve assistants, one female deputy, four process servers, one chief jailer and nine assistants, one matron and three assistants, one bookkeeper-cashier, one principal clerk, two clerk-stenographers and one senior clerk-typist. Said chief patrol deputy shall be allowed \$75.00 per month for the operation of his automobile. The titles herein mentioned shall not be controlling but shall be subject to change by the county board or other lawful authority.
- Sec. 2. That Laws 1947, Chapter 457, Section 2, be amended to read:
- Sec. 2. Yearly allowance for automobile purposes. Such sheriff shall be allowed a sum of not more than \$12,000 per annum for the purchase, care, maintenance, operation and upkeep of automobiles' insurance including liability and property damage covering the operator of the automobiles, firearms and other necessary equipment and paraphernalia to be used in the performance of the duties pertaining to his office.
- Sec. 3. Effective date. The act shall be effective January 1, 1950.
