report its findings to the Legislature not later than the 15th day after the opening of the next regular legislative session.

Sec. 4. Service without compensation or expense. Members of the commission shall serve without compensation or expenses, and may do all things reasonably necessary and convenient in carrying out the purposes of this act.

CHAPTER 413-S. F. No. 1046

An act relating to compensation of county commissioners in certain counties, and amending Laws of 1943, Chapter 402, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws of 1943, Chapter 402, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section. 1. Salaries of county board in certain counties. The salary and compensation of county commissioners in any county in this state now or hereafter having a population of not less than 55,000 nor more than 70,000, according to the last federal census, and consisting of not less than 35 nor more than 49 congressional townships, shall be the sum of \$1,200 per year to each commissioner of said county and in addition thereto each of said commissioners shall receive the sum of three dollars per day for each and every day necessarily oc-cupied in the discharge of their official duties while acting on any committee under the direction of the board, and five cents per mile each way for every mile necessarily traveled either in attending general or special meetings of the board or upon committee work, but the total amount in addition to said salary of \$1,200 aforesaid allowed to any one commissioner. in any one year, shall not exceed the sum of \$550.00, provided, however that the chairman of the county board of any such county shall receive in addition to the foregoing five cents per mile each way for going to the county seat to sign warrants during recess of the board.
