An act relating to county employees and their compensation in counties having a population of more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants; amending Laws 1943, Chapter 2, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1943, Chapter 2, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **Definition.** When used in this act the following words and phrases have the meaning ascribed to them in this section:

(1) County government means all officers and agencies of the county.

(2) County means any county *having more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants.*
