

CHAPTER 61—H. F. No. 284

An act relating to the probation officer in counties having more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants; amending Laws 1923, Chapter 289, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That Laws 1923, Chapter 289, Section 1, be amended to read:

Section 1. **Ramsey county; appointment of probation officer.** In every county having *more than 300,000 and less than 450,000* inhabitants and constituting a single judicial district there shall be appointed by the judges of such district a probation officer who shall serve for four years unless sooner removed by said judges.

CHAPTER 62—H. F. N. 286

An act fixing the salary of the county superintendent of schools and providing him with stenographic and clerical help in counties having more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants; amending Laws 1947, Chapter 464.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1947, Chapter 464, is amended to read:

Section 1. **Ramsey county; superintendent of schools; salary.** That in any county having *more than 300,000 and less than 450,000* inhabitants the board of county commissioners may fix the salary of the county superintendent of schools, which salary shall not exceed the sum of \$4,000 per annum and may provide him with necessary stenographic and clerical help.
