CHAPTER 632—S. F. No. 1240

[Coded as Section 98.47]

An act relating to licenses for the taking of wild animals, and amending Laws 1949, Chapter 150, Section 19, Subdivision 6.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Laws 1949, Chapter 150, Section 19, Subdivision 6, is amended to read as follows:

[98.47] **Exemptions to license requirements.** Subd 6. Except as otherwise expressly provided, the license to take small game shall be required of all persons taking same, and the license to trap fur bearing animals shall be required in addition where traps are used. The license to take fish by *angling* shall be required of all persons taking the same, but spearing and netting licenses shall be required in addition where those means are used.

CHAPTER 633—S. F. No. 1263

An act relating to wild animals and to the diversion of the waters of Pine Creek in the Province of Manitoba into the Roseau River Game Refuge and Public Hunting Grounds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation to the province of Manitoba relating to Pine Creek. Upon the completion, under authority of the department of public works or other authorized agency of the province of Manitoba, of the dams, ditches, control structures, and other works necessary for the diversion of the waters of Pine Creek in said province into the Roseau River Game Refuge and Public Hunting Grounds in the state of Minnesota, the commissioner of conservation, upon approving said project as effective and satisfactory for the intended purposes, is hereby authorized to pay to the authorized officer of said province the cost of such diversion works as certified by the agency in charge of construction and approved by the commissioner, not exceeding \$100,000.
