CHAPTER 1-H. F. No. 3

An act to appropriate money from the General Revenue Fund for the expenses of the Revisor of Statutes in drafting bills for the 1953 legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota: Section 1. Revisor of Statutes; appropriations. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the General Revenue Fund in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to the Revisor of Statutes for the purpose of paying expenses incurred and salaries of assistants temporarily employed in drafting bills for the 1953 Legislature, such sum to be available immediately. Approved January 28, 1953.
