An act relating to state lands, authorizing the exchange of certain state lands under certain conditions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Exchange of certain lands. Upon recommendation of the commissioner of conservation and with the approval of the land exchange commission, the following described state lands in Becker County, Minnesota, to-wit:

Lot 6, Section 2, in Township 140 North, Range 39 West;

Lot 10, Section 14, and Lot 8, Section 29, in Township 141 North, Range 39 West;

may be included in an exchange of lands with the United States or any agency thereof free from any or all conditions, limitations, restrictions, or reservations imposed by or pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 94.342, Subdivision 3.

CHAPTER 573—H. F. No. 1855

An act relating to the powers and duties of town boards in certain towns.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Town of Grand Rapids, salary of assessor. In any town having not less than 7,000 and not more than 10,000 inhabitants and an assessed valuation of more than \$2,000,000 and less than \$5,000,000 and containing two villages or more, not separated from the town for election and assessment purposes, one of which villages is the county seat, the town board, in addition to all other powers and duties, shall have power and authority to fix salaries paid to the assessor and his assistants, in lieu of the amount otherwise fixed by law, provided, however, the amount shall not exceed \$3,000 in any one year.
