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CHAPTER 250—S. F. No. 637

*An act relating to Otter Tail county; providing for salaries of county officers.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Otter Tail county, officers' salaries.** In Otter Tail county, the respective county officers shall receive as compensation for services rendered by them for the county, annual salaries to be fixed by the county board within the range for each office as follows:

(1) Register of deeds	\$6,750	\$7,500
(2) County superintendent of schools	6,000	7,000
(3) Sheriff	6,750	7,500
(4) County attorney	6,750	7,500
(5) Clerk of district court	6,750	7,500
(6) County auditor	6,750	7,500
(7) County treasurer	6,750	7,500
(8) County commissioner	2,000	2,400

**Sec. 2.** The fees of any such office of Otter Tail county shall be paid into the general revenue fund at the end of each calendar month and shall not constitute a part of the salary or compensation of such officers.

**Sec. 3.** The premium on the bonds required by law to be furnished by the county officers and their deputies in Otter Tail county shall be paid by the county.

**Sec. 4.** This act is in lieu of, and takes the place of Laws 1957, Chapter 377, as amended by Laws 1959, Chapter 377, and Laws 1961, Chapter 327.

Sec. 5. This act is effective upon its approval by a majority of the county board of Otter Tail county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 645.021.

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CHAPTER 251—H. F. No. 741

*An act authorizing the issuance of bonds and making of capital loans by Independent School District No. 14.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Independent school district No. 14; building bonds.** Notwithstanding the limitations of Minnesota Statutes, Section 475.53, and without being required to comply with Minnesota Statutes, Section 124.43, independent school district No. 14 is hereby authorized to issue and sell its bonds in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 over and above indebtedness heretofore incurred by it and loans made to it under the maximum effort school aid law, for the purpose of acquisition and betterment of schoolhouses. Approval of the voters shall be required to authorize such bonds in the manner provided by law. Such bonds may be sold and issued in such amounts and at such times as may be determined by the school board; provided, that if prior to issuing any of such bonds the district obtains any capital loan or loans under the maximum effort school aid law, the amount of bonds authorized hereby shall be deemed to be reduced by the amount of such loan or loans.

Sec. 2. The board also may issue and sell its bonds to pay the balance due upon any outstanding capital loan, or to refund any portion thereof, and may apply for and obtain a capital loan under the maximum effort school aid law, without the question of authorizing the incurring of such debt being submitted to the voters, provided the authorizing resolution is adopted by the favorable vote of all the members of the school board.

Sec. 3. The district may levy the taxes required by law for the payment of such bonds or loans and interest thereon without limitation as to rate or amount, and the levy of such taxes shall not cause the amount of other taxes, levied or to be levied by the district, which are subject to any such limitation, to be reduced in any amount whatsoever.

Sec. 4. This law shall become effective only after its ap-
