CHAPTER 296—S. F. No. 752

An act relating to applications for assistance for aid to dependent children; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 256.74, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 256.74, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **Aid to dependent children; application.** Application for assistance under sections 256.72 to 256.87 shall be made to the county agency of the county in which the dependent child is residing. *If the child is not residing within the state at the time of application but is eligible for assistance, the application may be made to the agency of the county where the child is present and forwarded to the agency of the county where the child last resided.* The application shall be in writing or reduced to writing in the manner and

upon the form prescribed by the state agency and verified by the oath of the applicant. The application shall be made by the person with whom the child will live and contain information as to the age and residence of the child and such other information as may be required by the rules and regulations of the state agency.
