upon the form prescribed by the state agency and verified by the oath of the applicant. The application shall be made by the person with whom the child will live and contain information as to the age and residence of the child and such other information as may be required by the rules and regulations of the state agency. One application may be made for several children of the same family if they reside with the same person.

An act relating to municipal courts; fixing the salary of the judge of municipal court of Alexandria.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Alexandria municipal court; judge's salary. The annual salary of the judge of the municipal court of Alexandria is \$3,900, notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 488.21, Subdivision 2.
- Sec. 2. The revisor of statutes in compiling the next edition of the Minnesota Statutes shall substitute the salary fixed in section 1 hereof for the salary specified for such judge in Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 488.21, Subdivision 2.
