upon the form prescribed by the state agency and verified by the oath of the applicant. The application shall be made by the person with whom the child will live and contain information as to the age and residence of the child and such other information as may be required by the rules and regulations of the state agency. One application may be made for several children of the same family if they reside with the same person.

300.55 **Corporations; stock certificates, to whom issued.** Upon payment in full of all amounts due any corporation from any person upon any certificate of its stock, and the surrender of all receipts, if any, issued therefor, he shall be furnished with a certificate, under the corporate seal, stating the number of shares and class of its stock owned by him, signed by its president or vicepresident, and by its secretary, under its corporate seal. or by such officers as the certificate of incorporation or bylaws may provide, but when a certificate is signed by a transfer agent or registrar the signature of any such corporate officer and the corporate seal upon such certificate may be fascimiles, engraved, or printed. The certificate shall be prima facie evidence of such ownership.
