

## CHAPTER 329—H. F. No. 1474

[Not Coded]

*An act relating to Cass county; providing for compensation of the county auditor.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Cass county; auditor's salary.** Subdivision 1. From and after January 1, 1964 the annual salary of the county auditor of Cass county shall be not less than \$8,000 nor more than \$10,000 as shall be determined by the county board.

Subd. 2. All fees collected by the county auditor shall be paid to the county in the manner and at the times prescribed by the county board.

Sec. 2. The aforesaid salary shall constitute the base salary and said auditor shall be entitled to any cost of living increase hereafter granted under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.43 and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon its approval by a majority of the members of the county board of Cass county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

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CHAPTER 330—H. F. No. 1530

*An act relating to the election of soil conservation district supervisors; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 40.05, Subdivision 3.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 40.05, Subdivision 3, is amended to read:

Subd. 3. **Soil conservation districts; elections.** After the effective date of Laws 1943, Chapter 274, all elections except that provided for the organization of the district, in subdivision 1, shall be held at the time and place of holding the annual spring town meeting and the town election officers shall act as the officers of the soil conservation district election. Election of supervisors of the soil conservation district shall be by separate ballot. Nominating petitions conforming to the rules stated in subdivision 1 shall be
