An act relating to road and bridge funds of unorganized townships in the county of Lake of the Woods; providing for transfer of such funds to the county road and bridge fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Lake of the Woods county; road and bridge funds. The county board of the county of Lake of the Woods may levy for the county road and bridge fund a tax not to exceed 41 mills on the dollar of the taxable valuation of all real and personal property located in unorganized townships within the county, exclusive of money and credits taxed under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Chapter 285.
- Sec. 2. The road and bridge funds in all unorganized townships in Lake of the Woods county are abolished, and all assets transferred to the county road and bridge fund. All outstanding lawful claims and demands upon such unorganized township road and bridge funds shall be assumed by the county road and bridge fund.
- Sec. 3. All laws now in force relating to road and bridge funds in unorganized townships in Lake of the Woods county, and all laws providing tax levies for such funds, insofar as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby superseded.
- Sec. 4. This act shall become effective upon its approval by a majority of the members of the governing body of the county of Lake of the Woods, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.
