CHAPTER 358—H. F. No. 682

[Not Coded]

An act relating to Independent School District No. 699; authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds for school building purposes and the levy of taxes for the payment thereof over and above existing limitations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Independent school district No. 699; building bonds. To provide moneys to reconstruct and rehabilitate the ventilating system in the technical building and to replace radiation, piping, and temperature controls in the technical building and senior high school building and to construct a new garage, independent school district No. 699 is empowered to issue its general obligation bonds in the sum of \$50,000, said bonds to be issued pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1961, Chapter 475. Said district is authorized to levy upon all taxable property in the school district a tax in excess of and over and above all taxing limitations, including, but not restricted to, limitations based upon population or mill rates, for the payment of said bonds.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of independent school district No. 699 and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
