

These pensions shall be uniform in amount, except as herein otherwise provided. No such pension shall be paid to any person while he remains a member of the fire department and no person receiving such pension shall be entitled to other relief from the association. No payments made or to be made by the association to any member on the pension roll shall be subject to judgment, garnishment, execution, or other legal process and no person entitled to such payment shall have the right to assign the same, nor shall the association have the authority to recognize any assignment or pay over any sum which has been assigned.

Sec. 2. This law shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the members of the village council of the village of Caledonia and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 430—H. F. No. 1551

An act granting the commissioner of conservation power to convey certain lands in Mahnomen county to clarify boundary lines.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Conveyance of state land; Mahnomen county.** The commissioner of conservation is hereby granted the power to make such conveyances as necessary, of state owned public access land located in government lot 3, section 20, township 146 north, range 39 west, Mahnomen county, for the purpose of correcting the boundary lines thereof.

CHAPTER 431—H. F. No. 1568

An act relating to the salaries of the auditor and treasurer of Wabasha county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Wabasha county, auditor and treasurer; salaries. The board of county commissioners of Wabasha county shall set the annual salary of the county auditor and county treasurer at not less than \$6,500 or more than \$7,500.

Sec. 2. Cost of living increase. The salaries set forth in section 1 shall constitute base salaries and the auditor and treasurer shall be entitled to any cost of living increases hereafter granted under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.43.

Sec. 3. Fees and payments. Nothing contained in section 1 of this act shall be construed as limiting the right of such officers to collect and retain fees, per diem payments, or any other payment which they are now authorized to collect in addition to the stated amount of their monthly salary.

Sec. 4. Effective date. This act becomes effective only upon approval by a majority of the board of county commissioners of Wabasha county and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 432—H. F. No. 1617

An act relating to firemen's relief association in the village of Mound.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Mound, village of; firemen's relief association, service pensions and eligibility. Upon reorganization of the village of Mound fire department, a firemen's relief association is hereby authorized therefor in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1961, Chapter 69; provided for purposes of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 69.28 the age limitation of 35 years shall not apply to firemen's relief associations existing prior to the annexation of Island Park by the village of Mound in said municipalities; and provided further for the purposes of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 69.06 a computation of years of active duty and years of membership in either a firemen's relief association existing prior to said annexation or the firemen's relief association authorized in this section shall be based upon active duty and years of membership in any one or more of

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
