

such fire departments or firemen's relief associations in said municipalities.

Sec. 2. Distribution of monies by state auditor. For purposes of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 69.34 warrants shall be issued to the treasurer of the relief association or associations associated with the fire department or departments active during such fiscal year and in the event more than one such department is active during said fiscal year the state auditor shall issue his warrant to the treasurer of the village of Mound who shall distribute the funds to the treasurer of the relief association or associations, ratably, on the basis of duration of active service of and the area served by each such fire department during said fiscal year.

Sec. 3. Distribution of tax by village treasurer. For the purposes of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 424.30, Subdivision 2, the treasurer of the village of Mound shall distribute the tax to the treasurer of the relief association or associations associated with the fire department or fire departments active during the year such tax was levied, ratably, on the basis of duration of active service of and the area served by each such fire department.

Sec. 4. Prior relief associations existence continued. Firemen's relief associations existing in said municipalities prior to said organization shall continue to exist for the purpose of administering funds received and benefits earned prior to the incorporation of the firemen's relief association authorized herein.

Sec. 5. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the village of Mound and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 433—H. F. No. 1679

An act relating to the construction and financing of water and sewer improvements by the town of Burnsville.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Burnsville, town of; water and sewer improvements. The town of Burnsville in Dakota county, for the purpose of paying the cost of any water improvement or sewer improvement or combined

water and sewer improvement ordered after hearing in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429, is authorized by resolution of its town board to establish and provide for the collection of rates and charges for water or sewer service or both and to pledge the net revenues derived therefrom to the payment of bonds issued under chapter 429 and interest thereon, in the same manner as is now permitted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 444.075, for the financing of village water and sewer systems. In the event that the special assessments and water and sewer revenues and any other funds pledged as required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 475.61 should at any time be insufficient to pay principal and interest due on such bonds, the town board shall levy a tax sufficient for that purpose upon all taxable property within the town, without limitation as to rate or amount. All taxable property within the town at the time of the delivery of any such bonds, whether or not subsequently detached and annexed by any means to any other political subdivision or municipality, shall be and remain subject to the levy of such tax, if necessary, until the bonds and interest thereon are fully paid. However, the town and any municipality or political subdivision succeeding the town in the ownership of the improvements financed by any such bonds shall do all things necessary and possible to assure the collection of special assessments and net revenues in the amount and at the times required to pay the bonds and interest when due, and any taxes levied upon any property after its detachment from the town shall be refunded to the municipality or other subdivision to which it has been annexed, when special assessments and net revenues have been received in amounts sufficient for this purpose.

Sec. 2. This act shall be in effect from and after its approval by resolution adopted by the vote of a majority of the members of the town board of the town of Burnsville, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 645.021.
