An act relating to payment of increases in pensions, annuities, and retirement payments heretofore or hereafter authorized.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. [352.725] Relief and retirement funds; requests for relief and retirement increases. Subdivision 1. No increase authorized by any law hereafter enacted, in any pension, annuity, or retirement paid by the public employees retirement association, the state employees retirement association, the state teachers retirement fund, any police or firemen's retirement fund, or from any relief or retirement fund to which contributions are made from moneys derived from taxation, shall be paid to any pensioner, annuitant, or recipient unless he shall first request in writing that payment of such increase be made.
- Subd. 2. No such increase as described in subdivision 1 under authority of any law heretofore enacted being paid on the effective date of this act shall continue to be paid to any pensioner, annuitant, or recipient unless he shall first request in writing that the payment of the increase be continued.

An act relating to the salary of the judge of probate court of Pope county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. **Pope county probate court; judge's salary.** The annual salary of the judge of probate court of Pope county is \$8,500, notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 525.081, Subdivision 1.
- Sec. 2. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 525.081, Subdivision 2, shall apply to the salary provided in Section 1.
