

CHAPTER 62—S. F. No. 330

An act appropriating money to the state college board for the national defense student loan fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. State colleges; national defense student loan fund; appropriation. There is appropriated to the state college board from the general revenue fund in the state treasury, the sum of \$32,191 for the national defense student loan program for the biennium ending June 30, 1963.

The moneys appropriated by this section are in addition and supplementary to the appropriation made by extra session Laws 1961, Chapter 89, Section 3, Subdivision 9.

Sec. 2. This act is in effect from and after its final enactment.

CHAPTER 63—S. F. No. 384

An act relating to reciprocity privileges for nonresident motor vehicle dealers; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 168.181 and adding a new subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 168.181, is amended to read:

Nonresident owners, reciprocity agreements or arrangements; conditions and limitations. Subdivision 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary or inconsistent herewith the registrar of motor vehicles with the approval of the attorney general is hereby empowered to make agreements with the duly authorized representatives of the other states, District of Columbia, territories and possessions of the United States or arrangements with foreign countries or provinces exempting the residents of such other states, districts, territories and possessions and foreign countries or provinces using the public streets and highways of this state from the payment of any or all motor vehicle taxes or fees imposed by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 168, subject to the following conditions and limitations:
