If this agreement shall be held contrary to the constitution of any state participating therein, the agreement shall remain in full force and effect as to the state affected as to all severable matters.

Sec. 2. [125.53] **Designated state official.** For the purposes of the agreement set forth in section 1, the designated state official for this state shall be the commissioner of education.

Sec. 3. [125.54] **Record of contracts.** Two copies of all contracts made on behalf of this state pursuant to the agreement set forth in section 1 shall be kept on file in the office of the commissioner of education.

CHAPTER 21—H. F. No. 357

An act relating to education; establishing continuing education; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 123.35, Subdivision 8.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 123.35, Subdivision 8, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. **Education; continuing education programs.** The board may establish and maintain public evening schools and adult *and continuing* education programs and such evening schools and adult *and continuing* education programs when so maintained shall be available to all persons over 16 years of age who, from any cause, are unable to attend the full-time *elementary or secondary school* schools of such district.

CHAPTER 22—H. F. No. 577

An act appropriating money for purchasing equipment for the third and fourth year curricula at southwest state college.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Southwest state college; equipment, appropriation. There is appropriated to the state college board from the general revenue fund in the state treasury the sum of \$350,000 to purchase equipment for the third and fourth year curricula at southwest state college. None of this appropriation shall cancel under any other provision of law and shall be available until expended.

CHAPTER 23—H. F. No. 692

An act relating to the operation of the state government; providing for additional appropriations to certain departments and agencies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Operation of state government; appropriations. Subdivision 1. There is appropriated to the persons, departments, and agencies hereinafter named, out of the general revenue fund in the state treasury, such additional sums of money as are specifically set forth in this section and for the purposes stated.

Subd. 2. Revisor of statutes as a supplement to the appropriation for bill drafting. \$ 18,940

Subd. 3. Department of administration

(1) Public property supplies and expense, supplement 60,600

(2) Printing session laws; bound volumes, supplement 12,500

Subd. 4. Department of conservation, division of forestry, salaries, supplement 75,000

Subd. 5. Retired supreme and district court judges and commissioners, salaries, supplies, and expenses 122,600

Subd. 6. Attorney general supplies and expenses 9,080

Sec. 2. This act is in effect from and after its final enactment.
