

CHAPTER 354—S. F. No. 2076

An act authorizing the conveyance by the state of certain land in Dakota county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Conveyance of state land; metropolitan airports commission. For the purpose of assisting in the correction of an erroneous description of lands within the statutory boundaries of Fort Snelling state park acquired by the Minneapolis—Saint Paul Metropolitan Airports Commission prior to the acquisition of adjacent lands by the state of Minnesota for park purposes, the commissioner of conservation, on behalf of the state of Minnesota, and for such consideration or terms as agreed upon, shall transfer and quitclaim to the Minneapolis—Saint Paul Metropolitan Airports Commission, a public corporation of the state of Minnesota, the following described land in Dakota county, Minnesota:

All that portion of Lots 24 and 25, James Slater's Addition to Mendota, included within the following described area: Beginning at a point approximately 3216 feet southeasterly of the southeasterly end of Runway 11R/29L, Minneapolis—Saint Paul International Airport (Wold—Chamberlain Field) and on the center line of said runway extended southeasterly, more particularly described as 819.74 feet west and 45.01 feet south of the east-1/4 corner of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 23 West of the 4th P.M., Dakota County, Minnesota; thence south $31^{\circ}19'42''$ west a distance of 200 feet; thence north $58^{\circ}40'18''$ west a distance of 430 feet, more or less, to the northwest line of Lot 25 of James Slater's Addition on the southeast bank of the Minnesota River; thence northeasterly along the northwest line of said Lot 25 on the southeast bank of the Minnesota River a distance of 418 feet; thence south $58^{\circ}40'18''$ east a distance of 309 feet; thence south $31^{\circ}19'42''$ west 200 feet to the point of beginning, containing approximately 4.0 acres, except that portion thereof of the above described area in Lot 24, James Slater's Addition to Mendota.
