An act relating to tax levies for general revenue purposes in Kanabec county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Kanabec county; general revenue tax levies. Notwithstanding the provisions and limitations of Minnesota Statutes, Section 275.09 to the contrary, the board of county commissioners of the county of Kanabec may levy annually a tax for general revenue purposes at such a rate as will produce not to exceed \$175,000.
- Sec. 2. Validating provision. Any levy made by the county board of Kanabec county prior to the effective date of this act for general revenue purposes in excess of any limitation provided by law is hereby validated.
- Sec. 3. This act takes effect when approved by the county board of Kanabec county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 419—S. F. No. 1270

An act relating to state forests; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 89.33, by adding a subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 89.33, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:
- Subd. 4. State forests; stock sales; sales of trees to soil and water conservation districts. The commissioner of conservation may supply tree planting stock to organized soil and water conservation districts for soil, water, wildlife and conservation purposes or as prescribed in section 89.31, subdivision 2.

There is no minimum limitation on the number of trees going on

an individual location. The district will make the determination of the numbers of trees going to each location.

Resale of trees with roots attached by the districts to their cooperators will be permitted if planted in accordance with conservation purposes set forth in section 89.31, subdivision 2.

The soil and water conservation districts will be permitted to resell trees with an adequate amount added to defray costs of handling, grading, transportation, storage, salaries and other costs directly related to planting the stock.

The district shall keep a record of all trees planted and the locations of the plantings. A record of the plantings shall be sent to the commissioner of conservation.

Soil and water conservation districts may establish joint distribution centers, if necessary, to facilitate distribution or improve quality of tree planting stock when approved by the commissioner of conservation and the soil and water conservation districts so affected.

- Sec. 6. St. Louis county; civil service.
