An act relating to emergency aid for school districts under Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 124.24; authorizing a supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Education; school districts; emergency aid; appropriation. There is appropriated from the state income tax fund in the state treasury to the state board of education the sum of \$1,500,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 for the purpose of making additional emergency aid grants to school districts in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 124.24.

Sec. 2. This act is in effect from and after its final enactment. Approved May 21, 1969.

## CHAPTER 532—H. F. No. 1997

An act relating to education; plans and specifications for school buildings; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 121.15.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 121.15, is amended to read:
- 121.15 Education; school districts; plans and specifications for temporary buildings. The state board shall prescribe rules for school sites and for the mechanical equipment, erection, enlargement, and change of school buildings. All plans and specifications for the erection, enlargement, and change of school buildings shall first be submitted to the state department of education for approval before the contract is let and no new school buildings shall be erected or any building enlarged or changed until the plans and specifications have been submitted to, and approved by, the state department. The state board shall include in such rules those made, from time to time, by the state board of health relative to sanitary standards for toilets, water supply, and disposal of sewage in public school buildings. In all other respects the authority to make rules for public school buildings
