## CHAPTER 696—S. F. No. 1415

An act relating to the towns of Marion and Rochester; salaries of certain employees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Rochester and Marion, towns of; salaries. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 367.06, and 368.80, the towns of Marion and Rochester in Olmsted county may set the salaries of the supervisors, clerks and treasurers of such towns at a sum not to exceed \$1500 per year for each such employee; provided, however, that the salary for each such employee for the portion of the year 1969 remaining after the effective date hereof shall not exceed \$1000.
- Sec. 2. The salaries of the officers described in section 1 may be set at the annual town meetings of the towns of Marion and Rochester or at a special meeting of such towns held in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 365.52.
- Sec. 3. This act takes effect as to each town affected by this act when approved by a majority of the voters at an annual or special election, and upon compliance by such town with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

## CHAPTER 697-S. F. No. 1585

An act appropriating money to independent school district No. 793, Staples, for certain additional state aid.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation; independent school district No. 793; state aid. There is appropriated from the general revenue fund in the state treasury the sum of \$43,000 to independent school district No. 793, Staples, for loss of gross earnings aid because of a decrease in the valuation of railroad property located in the district.
