

armed forces of the United States of America, the expiration date of his temporary certificate shall be extended by a period of time equal to the period or periods of time during which he served on such active duty.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 154.09, is amended to read:

154.09 Examinations, conduct and scope. The board of barber examiners shall conduct examinations of applicants for certificates of registration to practice as registered barbers and registered apprentices not more than four times each year, at such time and place as the board may determine. An affidavit shall be filed with ~~it~~ *the board* by the proprietor of a barber college or barber school that the student has completed ~~4,200~~ *1,500* hours in a duly approved barber school or barber college in the state.

The examination of applicants for certificates of registration as registered barbers and registered apprentices shall include both a practical demonstration and a written and oral test and embrace the subjects usually taught in schools of barbering approved by the board.

CHAPTER 917—S. F. No. 1699

[Coded in Part]

An act relating to state parks; increasing motor vehicle permit fees; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 85.05, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 85.05, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. State parks; motor vehicle permit fees. No motor vehicle shall enter or be permitted to enter any state park, memorial state park, state recreational reserve or wayside over 50 acres in area unless it has affixed to its windshield in the lower right corner thereof a permit which is provided for hereinafter. The commissioner of conservation shall procure permits in such form as he shall prescribe for each calendar year which by appropriate language shall grant permission to use any state park, memorial state park, state recreational re-

serve or wayside over 50 acres in area. Permits for each calendar year shall be provided and placed on sale before October 1 next preceding, and may be affixed and used on or at any time after said date until the end of the calendar year for which issued. Such permits in each category shall be numbered consecutively for each year of issue. A fee of \$2 \$3 shall be charged for each permit issued, except that permits of appropriate special design may be sold individually at 50 cents \$1 covering the use of state parks, memorial state parks, state recreational reserves or waysides under such conditions as the commissioner may prescribe for a designated period of not more than two days. The fee collected shall be deposited in the state park development account in the state treasury. Such permits shall be issued by such employees of the division of parks and recreation as the commissioner of conservation may designate in writing and as hereinbefore provided.

Subd. 3. [85.05] Application of permit fee changes. The provisions of this act relating to changes in permit fees applies to annual or two day permits issued for the calendar year 1970 and for each year thereafter.

CHAPTER 918—S. F. No. 2012

[Coded]

An act relating to counties having a population of more than 150,000; providing for the transferring of moneys between funds within the county budget.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Hennepin county; transfer between funds. Notwithstanding any provision of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 383.01 to 383.12 and Laws 1951, Chapter 556, Section 7, Subdivision 3, when the county board of Hennepin county determines that a deficit is imminent in one or more funds and there is a surplus existing in one or more of the remaining funds, the county board may transfer by resolution moneys within and between any funds. The total sum expended from all funds during any one fiscal year shall not exceed the total of all appropriations.
