2.2 appointed from a source other than the list furnished pursuant to subdivision 1 must provide
2.3 to the appointing authority the individual's major political party affiliation or a statement
2.4 that the individual does not affiliate with any major political party. An individual who
2.5 refuses to provide the individual's major political party affiliation or a statement that the
2.6 individual does not affiliate with a major political party must not be appointed as an election
2.7 judge. The appointments shall be made at least 25 days before the election at which the
2.8 election judges will serve, except that the appointing authority may pass a resolution
2.9 authorizing the appointment of additional election judges within the 25 days before the
2.10 election if the appointing authority determines that additional election judges will be required.

2.13 Subd. 3. **Election judge major party affiliation; data classification.** (a) Each
2.14 appointing authority must maintain a list of all election judges that indicates the major
2.15 political party affiliation of each election judge or a statement that the judge does not affiliate
2.16 with a major political party. A list created under this paragraph is public data on individuals.

2.17 (b) The lists described in subdivisions 1 and 2 are not public data on individuals.
