1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to state government; reducing the number of members of the legislature;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, sections 2.021; 2.031, subdivision 1.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 2.021, is amended to read:

1.6 **2.021 NUMBER OF MEMBERS.**

1.7 For each legislature, until a new apportionment shall have been made, the senate  
1.8 is composed of ~~67~~ 49 members and the house of representatives is composed of ~~134~~  
1.9 98 members.

1.10 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 2.031, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.11 Subdivision 1. **Legislative districts.** The representatives in the senate and house of  
1.12 representatives are apportioned throughout the state in ~~67~~ 49 senate districts and ~~134~~ 98  
1.13 house of representatives districts. Each senate district is entitled to elect one senator and  
1.14 each house of representatives district is entitled to elect one representative.

1.15 Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.16 Sections 1 and 2 are effective for members of the senate and the house of  
1.17 representatives to be elected at the 2016 general election, to take office in January 2017.
