- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to health care; requiring dispensed medications to contain a notice stating
- 1.3 that the medication must not be flushed or poured down a toilet or drain; amending
- 1.4 Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 151.212, subdivision 1.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 151.212, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Prescription drugs.** Drugs dispensed pursuant to a prescription shall
- 1.8 bear a label permanently affixed to the immediate container in which the drug is dispensed
- 1.9 and which is received by the purchaser. The label shall bear the name of the manufacturer
- 1.10 or distributor of the finished dosage form of the drug and all other information required by
- 1.11 law and by rules of the board. The label or container must also display a notice that states
- 1.12 that this medication must not be disposed of by flushing or pouring down a toilet or drain.
