1.9	commissioner may make grants for freight railroad preservation and improvement as provided

1.11	(b) Eligible recipients of grant funds under this subdivision consist of: (1) railroad
1.12	companies that are classified by federal law or regulation as Class II Railroads, Class II
1.13	Rail Carriers, Class III Railroads, or Class III Carriers; (2) rail users; and (3) local units of
1.14	government. An eligible recipient may receive funds regardless of a rail facility's ownership.
