1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 84.82, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 2. Application, issuance, issuing fee. (a) Application for registration or
1.7	reregistration shall be made to the commissioner or an authorized deputy registrar of motor
1.8	vehicles in a format prescribed by the commissioner and shall state the legal name and
1.9	address of every owner of the snowmobile.
1.10	(b) A person who purchases a snowmobile from a retail dealer shall make application
1.11	for registration to the dealer at the point of sale. The dealer shall issue a dealer temporary
1.12	21-day registration permit to each purchaser who applies to the dealer for registration. The
1.13	temporary permit must contain the dealer's identification number and phone number. Each
1.14	retail dealer shall submit completed registration and fees to the deputy registrar at least once
1.15	a week. No fee may be charged by a dealer to a purchaser for providing the temporary
1.16	permit.
1.17	(c) Upon receipt of the application and the appropriate fee, the commissioner or deputy
1.18	registrar shall issue to the applicant, or provide to the dealer, an assigned registration number
1.19	or a commissioner or deputy registrar temporary 21-day permit. Once issued, the registration
1.20	number must be affixed to the snowmobile in a clearly visible and permanent manner for
1.21	enforcement purposes as the commissioner of natural resources shall prescribe. A dealer
1.22	subject to paragraph (b) shall provide the registration materials or temporary permit to the

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- 2.1 purchaser within the temporary 21-day permit period. The registration is not valid unless
 2.2 signed by at least one owner.
- (d) Each deputy registrar of motor vehicles acting pursuant to section 168.33, shall also
 be a deputy registrar of snowmobiles. The commissioner of natural resources in agreement
 with the commissioner of public safety may prescribe the accounting and procedural
- 2.6 requirements necessary to assure efficient handling of registrations and registration fees.
- 2.7 Deputy registrars shall strictly comply with these accounting and procedural requirements.
- (e) A fee of \$2 In addition to that otherwise other fees prescribed by law shall be charged
 for, an issuing fee of \$4.50 is charged for each snowmobile registration renewal, duplicate
 or replacement registration card, and replacement decal and an issuing fee of \$7 is charged
 for each snowmobile registration and registration transfer issued by:
- 2.12 (1) each snowmobile registered by the <u>a</u> registrar or a deputy registrar and the additional
- 2.13 fee shall be disposed of must be deposited in the manner provided in section 168.33,
- 2.14 subdivision 2; or
- 2.15 (2) each snowmobile registered by the commissioner and the additional fee shall must
 2.16 be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the snowmobile trails and enforcement
 2.17 account in the natural resources fund.
