1.7	RELATIVES SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES.
1.8	Subdivision 1. <b>Issuance of plates.</b> The commissioner must issue Minnesota missing
1.9	and murdered Indigenous relatives special license plates or a single motorcycle plate to ar
1.10	applicant who:
1.11	(1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, noncommercial one-ton pickup
1.12	truck, motorcycle, or recreational vehicle;
1.13	(2) pays an additional fee in the amount specified for special plates under section 168.12
1.14	subdivision 5;
1.15	(3) pays the registration tax as required under section 168.013;
1.16	(4) pays the fees required under this chapter;
1.17	(5) contributes a minimum of \$25 annually to the Minnesota missing and murdered
1.18	Indigenous relatives account; and
1.19	(6) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and
1.20	licensing of drivers.

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Subd. 2. Design. In consultation with the Office of Missing and Murdered Indiger
Relatives, the commissioner must adopt a suitable plate design that includes a red hand
to one side, a partial ribbon skirt toward the bottom corner, and reads "Missing and Murc
Indigenous Relatives" or "MMIR."
Subd. 3. Plates transfer. On application to the commissioner and payment of a tra
fee of \$5, special plates issued under this section may be transferred to another motor ve
if the subsequent vehicle is:
(1) qualified under subdivision 1, clause (1), to bear the special plates; and
(2) registered to the same individual to whom the special plates were originally is
Subd. 4. Exemption. Special plates issued under this section are not subject to sec
168.1293, subdivision 2.
Subd. 5. Contributions; account; appropriation. Contributions collected under
subdivision 1, clause (5), must be deposited in the Minnesota missing and murdered
Indigenous relatives account, which is established in the special revenue fund. Money
the account is appropriated to the commissioner of public safety for distribution to the C
of Missing and Murdered Indigenous Relatives for investigation of unsolved cases an
establish a reward fund for information relating to missing and murdered Indigenous relating
The commissioner must not use money in the account for the cost of administering the
account funds.
<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective January 1, 2024, for Minnesota mis
and murdered Indigenous relatives special plates issued on or after that date
